## Leek Wootton Junior Football Club

### Playing Kit Policy

Leek Wootton FC (hereinafter referred to as the “*Club*”) provides playing kit to all players on the following basis:

1. The playing kit is defined as shirt, shorts, socks and tracksuit jacket as may be supplied from time to time;
2. There is no charge for the kit other than for any replacement kit that may be required in accordance with item 8 below;
3. Playing kit remains the property of the Club at all times;
4. If a player leaves the club for whatever reason the Club has the right to request for the return of all of the kit;
5. The kit should be worn for all Club matches, no alternative kit should be worn;
6. The Club will replace at no charge any kit damaged during Club matches;
7. The kit should not be worn for non Club games or training;
8. If a player (or parent) loses an item of kit or damages it beyond repair then the Club has the right to request payment for a replacement item;
9. Parents are requested to take care of the kit when washing and cleaning and should note that it should not be tumble dried or ironed as this could damage the kit;
10. Kit is often supported by sponsors and the Club likes to promote the relationship with sponsors through photos and news coverage in local media which could include a team photo being published.
